



Why support the Recovering America's Wildlife Act? (H.R. 4647 - Fortenberry and Dingell)

- Directs royalty revenue collected from oil and gas production on federal lands and waters to wildlife projects. These royalties not currently dedicated to other programs.
- Developed with input from national leaders in wildlife conservation, oil and gas industry, and outdoor recreation.
- Bipartisan bill that does not create new taxes.
- Texas is home to over 1,300 at-risk fish and wildlife species; H.R. 4647 is designed to keep them OFF the Endangered Species list through preventative conservation efforts.
- Texas would receive over \$60 million annually to fund qualified projects conducted by Texas state agencies, universities, non-profits, and private landowners.
- Keeping species off the Endangered Species list is good for wildlife, good for business, and saves taxpayer money.
- Supports the Texas outdoor recreation economy, which provides 277,000 jobs and accounts for \$28.7 billion in annual consumer spending.
